## Safeguard clauses / Super-safeguard clauses

- 1. Super-safeguard clauses only for Bulgaria, Romania (Postponement of accession from 1.1.2007 to 1.1.2008)
  - General (Art. 39 para. 1 AA-BR)
    - Against **both Bulgaria** and **Romania** (each separately)
    - For all areas of competence, in case of non-capacity to implement the acquis
    - Unanimous council decision on a recommendation by the Commission (COM)
  - > Specifically justice and home affairs/Schengen (Art. 39 para. 2 AA-BR)
    - Only against Romania
    - Only concerning justice and home affairs/Schengen (Annex IX Nr. I)
    - Council decision by **qualified majority** on a recommendation by COM
  - Specifically competition policy (Art. 39 para. 3 AA-BR)
    - Only against Romania
    - Only concerning **certain issues** of **economic policy** (Annex IX Nr. II)
    - Council decision by qualified majority on a recommendation by COM
  - => in all cases: <u>necessary</u> adaptation of the Act of accession by **Council** decision taken by qualified majority (Art. 39 para. 4 AA-BR).
- 2. <u>Standard safeguard clauses</u> (Suspension of certain rights from the acquis up to 3 years after accession)
  - General (Art. 37 AA-HR)
    - In <u>favor</u> (Art. 37 para. 1 subp. 1 AA-HR) and <u>against</u> (subp. 2) Croatia
      For all areas of competence, in case of difficulties which are serious
      and liable to persist in any sector of the economy
    - COM determines necessary measures, on application by a member state concerned
  - > Specifically for the internal market (Art. 38 AA-HR)
    - In case of serious breach of the functioning of the internal market
    - COM determines necessary measures, on application by a member state concerned or on its own initiative ("may" = equitable discretion)
  - Specifically justice and home affairs (Art. 39 AA-HR)
    - **Imminent risk** of **serious shortcomings** concerning the transposition of the acquis in the fields of **police**, **criminal or civil law**
    - **COM determines necessary measures**, on application by a member state concerned **or on its own initiative** ("may" = equitable discretion)
